<u>Introduction:</u> Are you living distracted or devoted?

[4] But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first. [5] Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. [Rev 2:4-5]

[42] And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. [43] And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. [44] And all who believed were together and had all things in common. [45] And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. - 5. They experienced the awesome supernatural work of God in their lives and in their midst.
- 6. They were led spiritually by chosen men who operated in God's power.
- 7. They met together regularly in both large and small groups in Jesus' name.
- 8. They had a powerfully positive influence on the people around them.
- 9. God was saving people daily and the church was growing rapidly.
